## **Key issues arising with actions**

- ✓ 30 % of parents believe that the school website does not provides them with clear information regarding what has happened in school or about future actions.
- Action: Continue to update website with weekly newsletter and information. Revisit website design post SAT period.
  - ✓ 28% of parents do not believe that they are kept well-informed about what their child is learning in school or how to help them at home. (22%)
- Action: Curriculum maps/attendance/behaviour information displayed in entrance area.

Continue to display curriculum maps, events, calendar etc. on school website.

Continue to send weekly newsletters.

Information sessions for parents of pupils in Years2 and 6 to be organised.

Homework expectations to be displayed on windows facing parent pickup area.
